music tuition 2011 - 2012

Our academic year is divided into two parts: the school-year term and the summer term. Tuition is paid in seven installments: six for the school-year term and one for the summer term.

Lessons are weekly through the school year (36 scheduled lessons) and flexible through the summer. The summer session includes six lessons, or a [combination of lessons and workshops](#).

Your first payment may be prorated based on

**Traditional Plan (includes six lessons per payment)**

20-minute lessons weekly (for age five and younger only): \$140

30-minute lessons weekly: \$210

45-minute lessons weekly: \$310

60-minute lessons weekly: \$400

**Floating Plan (includes four lessons per payment)**

Lessons occur during off-peak hours (before 3 PM or after 7 PM on weekdays throughout the school year and on Saturdays and Sundays, subject to availability).

30-minute lessons: \$140

45-minute lessons: \$210

60-minute lessons: \$280

**Other Fees**

- \$50 Registration Fee per family, to be included in August 1 payment. This fee is waived for returning students who paid summer tuition.
- Materials: Books, strings, etc., are purchased as needed.
- Additional lessons "a la carte" are \$32 per half-hour for students already enrolled in the Traditional Plan, \$35 per half-hour for students enrolled in the Floating Plan, and \$40 per half-hour for students who are not currently enrolled. These must be paid in advance at the time of booking.

**Tuition Due Dates**

May 1, 2012 (summer tuition)

**Notes**

- Tuition payments received more than five days after the due date are subject to a \$20 late fee.
- If a student's tuition for the upcoming session has not been received within ten days after the due date, the student may be dropped from our roster for that session.
- Your last payment of the year (March 15) may be prorated to account for lessons that have been cancelled by the school. The amount by which the payment will be prorated will be calculated by Eclectic Music.
- No tuition payment amount should be adjusted or prorated without the prior consent of our office.
- Tuition includes performances all recitals, festivals, open-mics, and more.
